Camping: Provision for camping / caravanning for participants only is made in a designated area in the Lowther Gardens or on Lytham Green. Camping is allowed by prior arrangement only, so please state this on the participant application form. Camping on the Event area is strictly limited to WW2 / Army camouflage tents as part of the confirmed living history displays. The site must be fully clear by 7pm Sunday. **There is a fee of £5.00 per night charge.**

Parking: Make sure you have your vehicle pass displayed once you get it from the Security tent. If asked, you may have to move your car to Performers / Re-enactors Parking which is near the Windmill on the Green.

You will not be allowed to park your car anywhere other than the designated event parking areas with your parking pass. All public pay and display areas on the Green and in town will be in operation and can be used at

your own expense. Official passes are for official re-enactors only. Members of the public visiting are requested to park in the official designated car park and pay a fee of £5 per day.
