Set in seventy-eight acres of wooded parkland, this grade one Georgian listed building is the historic home to the Clifton family. Built between 1757 and 1764, the stunning house is set over three floors and there are outbuildings, including a popular dog friendly tea room, the Leafy Lytham Garden Hub run by Greg Anderton and Antiques store. Open all year round (except Boxing Day) and offering free entry to the grounds, Lytham Hall is a fantastic backdrop to many functions and year-round events. In the summer there's outdoor theatre on the extensive lawns too. House tours are available by prior arrangement. For more information call 01253 736652 or refer to the Lytham Hall website.



Lytham Windmill

Lytham Windmill can be found on Lytham Green. It was originally designed to grind wheat or oats to make flour or bran. Laid out over five floors there's plenty of interesting displays portraying the history of mills and milling in the area, plus the 'Great Lifeboat Disaster' and the 'Heritage of Lytham St Annes and the Fylde Area'. There's free entry and donations are welcome, plus a seasonal Tourist Information Desk. At night the windmill is lit up, often in vibrant colours in line with a national celebration or event. St Annes Beach

The extensive sandy beach in St Annes on the Sea has a backdrop of the Victorian Pier. Just to the north of the pier, there's an extensive dune network and plenty of space to have some quiet time. There's modern luxurious multi award winning beach huts, 18-hole mini links golf course and eighteen hole putting green. There's a mini train for our young visitors in the summer as well as trampolines, playground and more. During summer there's donkey rides, bouncy castle and more, two water play areas (free of charge), including **SPLASH!**, the bandstand, the well-presented Green Flag graded Promenade Gardens. The <u>St Anne's International Kite Festival</u> takes place on the beach adjacent to the pier and dates vary according to the tidal conditions.

<u>Farmers Markets & Indoor Markets</u> (All year round)

<u>St Annes Farmers Market</u> – 1st Thursday of every month - 9am – 1pm. Held within St Annes Centre on the car parks, traders run this market – Fabulous selection of stalls offering local and Lancashire produced items – mostly food but some non-food. Pop along and buy local and indulge in the wonderful variety while supporting farmers & small business.



<u>Lytham Farmers Market</u> – 3rd Thursday of every month (except January and December) 8am-1pm in the centre of Lytham.

A traditional market offering local homemade goods including food, drink and local craft stalls.
